

After further clarification was sought regarding community sport, we are pleased to announce that golf is back on and the Club will be operating from 6.00am tomorrow (Monday, 9th August).

**All patrons of the Club must sign in using the Check In QLD App prior to the use of any of the Club facilities.**

From Monday, the following restrictions will be in place:

### **GOLF COURSE**

- Golf is permitted for the purpose of exercise to residents of our Local Government Area (Moreton Bay region).
- Golf can be played in groups of 4 players, however, masks must be worn at all times whenever physical distancing cannot be maintained.
- Golf carts may be used but only one (1) person per cart is permitted (unless you are from the same household).
- **All competitions will be restricted to Members only**, and will be changed to Single Stableford.
- **Social play is open to residents of our LGA.**
- NTPs, Junior purse etc are not permitted.
- Flags to remain in the holes, and bunker rakes will be removed.
- No major competitions, no interclub competitions and no open days are to occur.
- At this stage, presentations are not permitted.

### **CLUBHOUSE**

- Masks must continue to be worn indoors, except for while seated and eating or drinking. Masks must also continue to be worn outdoors where physical distancing is not possible. The Club Policy is No Mask = No Entry and there are No exceptions, medical or otherwise. Those with medical exemptions for mask wearing will not be permitted into the Clubhouse.
- Patron density limits of one (1) person per four (4) square meters indoors and one (1) person per two (2) square meters outdoors. Our furniture will be arranged to cater for this and must not be rearranged.
- Patrons must be seated while eating and drinking, at which point the mask may be removed for the purposes of consuming food or drink.
- Takeaway food is also still available with our limited takeaway menu.
- There is no dancing, except at weddings.

### **PRACTICE FACILITIES**

- All practice facilities are open for use, however, physical distancing is to be maintained, else mask must be worn.

These restrictions are in the best interests of the members, the Club, the Local Community and all Queenslanders. They are not to be taken as what could be done, they are to be taken as what **must** be done.

These restrictions are expected to be in place for the next two weeks but as be seen before, this may change. members will be notified as soon as possible of any changes.
